ELIGIBILITY: Restricted to registered members of an Yorkshire Centre ACU Club. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership. (Please abide by current travel restrictions/ advice due to Covid19).

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1 Group A1 solos and TSR 8.

CLASSES: - Adult: Expert, Intermediate, Novice, Clubman's & Clubman's Easy. Youth: A, B and C.

(Rider may choose to ride out of class on any route on a non-competitive / no awards basis).

Conducted: - 3 Small Wheel Classes. (These will count towards Club annual awards).

START: - 11.00 a.m. (No Engines to be run until instructed). No petrol available at start. **VENUE**: - Parkwood Offroad Centre, Home Farm, Tong Lane, Tong, Nr Bradford. BD4 0RR.

ENTRIES: Pre-Entry Only via the ACU online event entry www.acu.org.uk/events/Trials/.

(Please make sure that your membership and personal profile are up to date on your ACU portal). Entries will open 20/03/21 and close on 14/04/21 and will be limited to 80 allocated as follows: -

Those providing an observer, existing members, first come and route availability.

Only those who fulfil the Eligibility criteria will be allowed to enter. (No Day Membership or Registrations).

You will be notified of your entry acceptance and riding number by email.

Instructions on how to obtain your riding number and register at the event will also be sent.

ENTRY FEE: Adult Classes: £20.00. Youth Classes: £15.00. Conducted £10.00

Note: A Surcharge of £3 will be deducted from entry fees when refunded by the ACU in event of cancellation.

COVID 19: The event will be run under the current guidelines issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to.

Travel to Event and Parking: Only one person should travel in a vehicle unless from same household. Parking must be such that social distancing requirements are implemented at all times especially during unloading / loading.

Parking at Sections: On arrival at a section all riders must observe social distancing and MUST not park or queue near another rider. If section busy move on to next section.

Inspecting Section: Only three riders allowed in section at any time to inspect it without lingering. A one-way route walking the section as to be ridden, with social distancing to be strictly adhered to by riders passing other riders in section.

General: Please follow all signage and instructions. Failure to comply will result in you been asked to leave the venue.

RESULTS: - Will be posted on the club website www.horsforthtrials.co.uk. and elsewhere in the public domain.

Those wanting hard copies must provide a SAE envelope with entry.

AWARDS: - Hard Course Best Performance: - The Rebbecca Hoare Memorial Trophy* & replica to Value £10.00

1st Each Class: - Award to value £10.00.

Clubman's Course: - Best Performance: - The Ackroyd Trophy* & replica to Value £10.00

Easy Course: - Best Performance: - Award to Value of £10.00.

Youth Awards: - Best Each Class an award.

*(Trophy's to be held for 1 year).

(Awards are subject to a min. entry per class). No person to win more than one award).

COURSE: - Main: 3 Routes all on private land with 3 Laps of approx. 2 miles per lap, with 12 Sections per lap.

The number of sections, laps and method of course closure or time limit to be confirmed on the day.

Conducted: 3 Routes. The number of sections and laps will be decided on the day.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22a; stop permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23.

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

GENERAL: <u>Strictly No Spectators or Dogs.</u> - Please take all your litter home.

Please read all the following instruction before proceeding into the venue

- Do NOT enter if you have the following symptoms
 - o A high temperature
 - A new continuous cough
 - o Change in sense of taste or smell
 - o Are Resident in Higher Tier Risk Area

If you have any of the above, turn around and go home

- No entries will be accepted on the day (pre-entries only).
- Always observe social distancing
- Sanitise hands when instructed to do so.

Instructions -

- 1. Park your vehicle ideally 2m away from the next vehicle.
- 2. Facemasks should be worn in communal areas and where 2m distance cannot be maintained.
- 3. Proceed to the event secretaries station observing entry and exit signage maintaining social distancing from other competitors and officials.
- 4. Collect your riding number from one of the 3 coloured boxes, before touching the boxes sanitise your hands with the sanitiser provided.
- 5. Show your riding number to the event secretary ensuring that he/she acknowledges your entry.
- 6. Return to your vehicle until the start of the event.

The start of the event will be signalled via a car horn. You may be directed to start at particular sections, observe these instructions.

During the event -

- No more than 3 people at anyone time to walk a section (in one direction only), exit the section at the end and return to your machine, do NOT walk back down the section.
- Maximum of 6 people to queue at a section at a spacing of 2m. If there are already 6 people in the queue either stop and wait or proceed to the next section.
- Do NOT approach the observer.
- If a marker flag is dislodged the rider is responsible for replacing it at the direction of the observer.
- On completion of the event please return to your vehicle immediately.

These rules must be followed, and we will be operating a zero-tolerance policy for any breaches. If you are an observer or have brought an observer, please ring 07974910714 for further instructions.
